中年級朗讀組：每班推薦 1 名代表參加。

五、比賽時間：

三年級：114 年 1 月 10 日（五）上午第 3 節。

四年級：114 年 1 月 10 日（五）上午第 4 節。

五年級：114 年 1 月 10 日（五）下午第 5 節。

上課鐘響未到比賽場地者即取消資格，不得入場。

六、比賽地點：仁愛樓 2F 會議室。

七、比賽題目：

1. 國小高年級說故事組：自選一則故事參與競賽。

2. 國小中年級朗讀組：朗讀稿 3 篇抽選一篇。

八、報名方式：

即日起至 12 月 24 日（二）中午 12:30 止，請將報名表交至教務處郁璇老師。12 月 26 日（四）中午 12:30 於會議室抽出場順序，中年級繼續抽出一篇文章進行競賽。

九、 評審各組比賽時間：

1. 評審委員：聘請專長教師，各比賽項目三人擔任評審委員評定之。

2. 評分標準及時間：

(1) 高年級說故事組：以 3 分鐘為準，時間在 2 分 30 秒至 3 分 30 秒之間不扣分。於限時前 30 秒、限時後 30 秒響鈴提醒，時間不足或超過 30 秒扣 1 分，未足 30 秒以 30 秒計。

(2) 中年級朗讀組：以 1 分鐘為限，聽到鈴聲後請下台。

(3) 說故事組參賽者運用道具裝扮由本人帶上台；朗讀組學生均不得攜帶道具。

(4) 比賽人員請依報到時間地點準時出席，逾時以棄權論；唱名三次後未出場者亦同。

(5) 比賽人員服裝，以高雅大方符合禮儀為準，且列為「儀態」項目評分標準評分。

十、 獎勵：

1. 五年級說故事組：取前三名

第一名獎金 300 元及獎狀乙紙；第二名獎金 200 元及獎狀乙紙

第三名獎金 100 元及獎狀乙紙；佳作數名獎狀乙紙

2. 中年級朗讀組：三、四年級組各取前三名

第一名獎金 300 元及獎狀乙紙；第二名獎金 200 元及獎狀乙紙

第三名獎金 100 元及獎狀乙紙；佳作數名獎狀乙紙
